- Aluminum food and beverage containers with food debris removed; labels do not need to be removed
- Glass food and beverage containers with lids and food debris X Polystyrene foam, foam cups, dinnerware, packing foam or removed; labels do not have to be removed
- Natural and pigmented placed narrow-neck containers with symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 (milk bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, etc.); food and beverage debris must be removed; labels do not need to be removed; lids must be attached to the bottle
- Ferrous (iron, steel, tin) cans with food debris removed
- Food and beverage cartons such as milk, soup and broth; lids must be removed
- Newsprint black and white or pigmented; not bound or placed in bags
- Construction paper, kraft paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, or similar
- Printer paper, computer paper, copy paper
- Junk mail
- Magazines, catalogs
- Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and cut, and can be no larger than 14 x 14 inches

Service Notice: If a Holiday falls on or before your service day, service will be one day later. If the Holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no change in service.
