The meeting was opened with the pledge of allegiance and a moment of silence for the sick, handicapped, departed and military personnel of the community.

ROLL CALL

Virginia Schneider – absent due to work obligation. SouthBridge EMS, Dan Miller – absent.

VISITORS, PLEASE STATE NAMES AND ADDRESSES

Pasquale DeBlasio – 132 Pennsylvania Avenue; stated his appreciation for the council except Virginia Schneider and Mayor Copeland for the work that has been done over the years in an attempt to alleviate flooding. He clarified his remarks as to not including Mayor Copeland and Councilwoman Schneider saying they were both new and therefore have only been involved this past year.

Randy Thomson – Baldwin Street; asked questions about concerns he heard that the Borough was widening Baldwin Street; he didn't understand what was happening. Council President Michael Tolmer explained that nothing was happening at this time, that the Planning Commission has been working on various solutions to alleviate flooding issues.

Dale Livingston – Cook School Road –representing the Lions Club, which was chartered here in Bridgeville area 2 years ago and has 23 members. Mr. Livingston stated the function of the Lions Club and stressed the importance of needing new members to continue the good works. Mr. Livingston listed the many areas where the Lions Club has given help to area residents such as defibrillators to the Police Department; Smoke Detectors to the Fire Department to give out to those in need; Eye Glasses for those who in need.

Dan Hupp – here with Mr. Livingston representing the Lions Club. Mr. Hupp recapped the help the Lions Club gave during the flood. He stated the group worked with churches in the area to help those in need clean up and refurbish their homes. The Lions Club was able to obtain a \$10,500.00 grant from the International Lions Club to help our residents. With the help of Bridgeville United Methodist Church and Crossroads Church they were able to help 20 homes clean up; Carrier donated new furnaces to a few homes and the Lions Club paid for installation of duct work and furnace. Mr. Hupp stated the Lions Club would like to see the Borough initiate an immediate response team as a way to coordinate efforts to help in situations like the flood in the quickest way possible. This could be coordinated through churches and area groups to have a disaster recovery plan in action for storage of donated goods, donations of money and services and other ways to be able help immediately should the need arise. Mr. Hupp submitted a report of Neighbors Helping Neighbors – Flood Relief and Recovery Progress Report, a copy of which is attached to these minutes.

Gary Palmer – 924 Ella Street – addressed Council concerning areas that are in need of attention in the Borough. Mr. Palmer raised questions regarding property maintenance and abandoned vehicle compliance. Zoning Compliance Officer Lori Collins addressed Mr. Palmer's concerns and asked that he call her with the names and property locations and if they were found non-compliant with maintenance and/or zoning she would send the owners letters to bring the property in to compliance. Ms. Collins explained the process starting with a letter and then if issues aren't address and areas not brought in to compliance the owner would be taken to the Magistrate. Police Chief Chad King explained the process for a vehicle being declared abandoned.

Greg Jones – Mr. Jones was here representing a consortium of churches in the area. He invited all to attend a special service honoring Dr. Martin Luther King on Monday, January 21, 2019 at the Solid Rock Revival Church at 610 Dewey Avenue. This event is sponsored by Solid Rock Revival Church, Bethany Presbyterian Church, Bower Hill Community Church and First Baptist Church of Bridgeville. Manager Collins stated she would have the event advertised on the Borough FaceBook.

Bob Fryer – Bridgeville Towers, 479 Bank Street Extension – Mr. Fryer stated his various concerns and solutions regarding traffic issues and flooding in the Borough. Mr. Fryer stated he has received cost estimates from professionals at PennDOT and Lane Construction. Council President Tolmer requested that Mr. Fryer supply the list of names and contact information of the PennDOT professionals that Mr. Fryer states have given him prices and costs to implement his solutions. Councilman Colosimo requested the name of the professional from Lane Construction who provided the cost estimate to implement Mr. Fryer's plan. No information was forthcoming from Mr. Fryer regarding those requests.

Mr. Fryer again brought large visuals and drawings and diagrams of his various solutions to these problems to this meeting.

Mike Chiodo – 233 Station Street. Mr. Chiodo provided photographs of trees along the railroad tracks near his home that are in need of either trimming or removal. Mr. Chiodo also spoke of tires and debris on the property behind the former Norwood Party House. Zoning Compliance Officer Lori Collins stated she would be in contact with her connection at the Railroad to have issues addressed concerning railroad property and that she would investigate the tires and debris behind the former Norwood Party House and deal with that issue with the property owner.

ADMINISTRATION, BRUCE GHELARDUCCI – Councilman Ghelarducci had no report.

PARKS & RECREATION, JOSEPH COLOSIMO – Councilman Colosimo had no report.

PUBLIC WORKS/BUILDINGS, NINO PETROCELLI, SR. – Councilman Petrocelli stated that Public Works has begun ice and snow removal.

PUBLIC SAFETY, WILLIAM HENDERSON – Councilman Henderson discussed the 90-day temporary stop sign at Winfield and Lafayette streets has been successful in that there have been no violators and caused no traffic backups. He asked for a motion to make the stop sign permanent.

A motion made by William Henderson and seconded by Bruce Ghelarducci to advertise the Ordinance to install a permanent stop sign at Winfield and Lafayette. All in favor, motion carried 6-0.

MAYOR, BETTY COPELAND - Mayor Copeland reported that she had the honor of swearing in the 2019 officers for the Bridgeville Volunteer Fire Department. She also reported that Chief King received a thank you card from a little girl for the bicycle Buddy the Elf gave her.

POLICE CHIEF, CHAD KING – Chief King gave a statistical report of 3,234 calls answered in 2018. Chief King reported on the Buddy the Elf event on December 23, 2018. He stated there were many gifts donated that were distributed to the children who attended the event as well as the remainder of the gifts were given out by Santa and Mrs. Claus as they rode through town with the Bridgeville Volunteer Fire Department. Chief King congratulated the winner of the maple syrup chugging contest – Council President Michael Tolmer!

SOLICITOR, THOMAS MCDERMOTT - Solicitor McDermott stated he has provided everyone with a copy of his written report.

ENGINEER, JOE SITES – Engineer Sites stated he has provided everyone with a copy of his written report.

FIRE CHIEF, WILLIAM CHILLEO - Fire Chief Chilleo highlighted the need for more volunteers at the fire department. He stated that the smoke detectors donated by the Lions Club are handed out at fire scenes. Chief Chilleo recounted an incident where a resident checked the internet regarding carbon monoxide levels in her home and followed the directions to open windows; however when windows were later closed the levels in their home reached dangerous levels. 9-1-1 was then called. Chief Chilleo stressed the importance of calling 9-1-1. Turned out to be a faulty furnace and the end result could have been fatal. Chief Chilleo stated he will have a full report for Council next month. The department responded to over 500 calls in 2018, which was a big increase over 2017.

BOROUGH MANAGER, LORI COLLINS Borough Manager Collins conveyed her thanks to Deb Colosimo for volunteering and helping out in the office these past few weeks and tonight. Manager Collins stated she has provided everyone with a copy of her written report.

NEW BUSINESS – Councilman Verduci stated that the Bridgeville Athletic Association is holding signups January 12, 17 and 26.



Backflow Preventers – Baldwin Street

Osiris Enterprises has completed the work on the installation of the backflow preventers on Baldwin Street. The only remaining backflow preventer to be installed is located on New York Street and they are to be back before the end of the month to complete the installation. We have discussed with the manager where the installation of backflow preventers in the Carol Avenue and Maple Street areas of the borough. Letters of interest will be sent to property owners in these areas and agreements will need to be executed for completion.

2018 Point Repair Contracts

Niando Construction is substantially completed with the point repairs in the Borough. The manager is in receipt of Application for Payment 4 in the amount of \$32,080.93. We are in the process of reviewing their completed work and as-built video inspections. Once our review is completed, we will release the retainage for the final payment.

Green Light Go Project

The contracts have been executed with Bronder Technical Services for the project and the joint pre-construction meeting with PennDOT has been held. The scope of work will complete upgrades to the signalized intersections of Washington Avenue (S.R. 0050) and Station Street (S.R. 3005) / Station Street, Washington Avenue (S.R. 0050) and Bower Hill Road / Murray Street. The upgrades include the installation of new traffic signal equipment including traffic signal controllers; adaptive traffic signal systems (video); and acoustic emergency vehicle preemption. All associated traffic control and restoration is also included, complete in place. All work is schedule to be completed by May 31, 2019.

2019 Pavement Maintenance Program

We would request a meeting with the Public Works Committee to begin the process of determining the roads to be included in the 2019 Pavement Maintenance Program.

McLaughlin Run Water Shed Storm Projects

We are working on completion the field work for the Jane Way Access Ramp and lowering of the McLaughlin Run Park Ballfield. Our schedule is to have a plan prepared by the end of February for submission to the Allegheny County Conservation District to obtain the necessary permits.

WALL PROJECT BEHIND DARI-DELITE

One of the only projects that we can move forward with in the next few months to be proactive with our Hazard Mitigation strategies would be the construction of some type of wall behind the Dari-Delite per the request of Fred Valentino when he attended the meeting a few months ago. I have requested Engineer Sites review the area again, determine what is needed and move forward with the plan. Hopefully in the spring we could be able to begin. It will involve clearing that public works can handle and we can then go from there. Public Works may be able to handle the entire project; we will have to look at the design and decide. This type project will require an easement, but I'm sure that we will have no problem obtaining it from the property owner.

AUDIT YEAR 2018

The 2018 audit has been completed by our auditing firm Hosack, Specht, Muetzel and Wood. The audit went well. We will receive their final report by March 31, 2019.

2018-2019 REPORTS

I am in the process of submitting required reports for the year ending 2018 and beginning 2019. Due dates start January 15, 2019 and continue until March 31, 2019.

COUNTY HAULING

On the 5th week of collection which would have been January 30th, I sent correspondence to Mr. McKeating of County Hauling noting that it was our expectation that the garbage and recycling misses should be handled the same day; and trash being left behind on the street should completely discontinue. I noted a proactive approach on their part could be taken to have a supervisor in the Borough on pick-up day monitoring the situation and misses first hand. I will be requesting a meeting with the owner of the company as we in the office feel that problems continue to persist and have not improved. I will inform Council of the meeting date should you want to attend.

BOARD AND COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS

I have placed the remaining Board and Commission appointments on the agenda for your consideration. At this time, we still have the following terms open:

Civil Service – one term
Planning Commission – two terms
Zoning Hearing Board – 1 term

I have provided the information received from the individuals wishing to be considered to serve. Should you want to meet with them prior to appointments, please let me know, I will schedule it.

GROW GRANT APPLICATION – ALCOSAN

Update: A letter of interest will be provided to ALCOSAN for the Grow Grant with the area of work to be the sanitary sewer at the rear of New York Street that flows to Coolidge and into the interceptor on McLaughlin. The full application is due June 28, 2019.

BACKFLOW PREVENTER PROJECT

We are now reviewing the next phase of the project. Our budget will be less than last year. We may look to Railroad and the area behind the Borough building such as Brookfield, Carol, etc. I will send surveys to see how many in these areas have the device and how many are in need of one.

EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK

Work will continue to update the employee handbook. I will insert all suggestions and provide an updated copy for Council's review. The inserts will be highlighted so that all changes may be considered. Work will continue on the job descriptions.

TUSCANY POINT

The engineer and the owner of the property to be called Tuscany Point in Upper St. Clair requested a meeting with Engineer Sites and I to review zoning requirements for the parcel of the project that is located in Bridgeville Borough. The parcel is designated Conservation. The use they are planning is a recreation facility which is a conditional use in our Conservation District. Please note that at this time we have received no formal application. I will notify Council and the Solicitor at the time one is received.

FLOOD AND MITIGATION UPDATE

Letters and surveys have been sent to property owners on Baldwin Street to determine who may be interested in participating in the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. Letters of Interest are due February 28th. Deadline for residents to return the surveys to me is February 15th. I will provide information on how many I have received to Council on the 15th.

I will keep the following in the report until we have updated information to provide in case residents question what has been done to date.

The following is an update as to where we are regarding the flood and work completed to date. Some of the information may be redundant from previous reports:

- The construction of the Maple Street Wall has been completed.
- The extra course of block has been placed in the area behind the beer warehouse
- As a result of the meeting with the DEP on August 23, 2018, Engineer Sites is preparing costs and specifications for short term, mid-term and long term projects so that we can apply for all of them. Some require dual permits from the DEP and conservation district. Permits can take from 4 months to 1 year. Once we are provided cost estimates, we can decide if we want to pursue funding through Pennvest (they supply municipal loans at 1.875%) or other forms of funding.
- We will continue to meet with the County regarding our progress and their willingness to assist with the bridge replacement.
- The Chartiers Valley Flood Authority will assist with some of the work that needs to be done in the back channel. We need to contact Collier Township to become involved with the portion of McLaughlin Run that is not flowing or open within their municipality.
- The three municipalities affected by the flood, Bethel, USC and Bridgeville met on September 25th at the Gateway Offices. Sharing information was discussed along with planned projects within

each municipality. We will be meeting every other month and providing information regarding projects and mapping that will be posted on all of our websites to keep residents aware of what is planned.

- Engineer Sites and I held a meeting with an intern from his office that has some experience in hazard mitigation grants. I think she and I will work well together. She is going to begin the research portion of the process along with the mapping. After we have a full understanding of the program, we will offer it to residents that would like to take advantage of opportunity. It is strictly voluntary. With her help we should get this program underway in a timely manner.

BALDWIN STREET CONCEPT STUDY

No Update: The planning commission made a motion at a special meeting on October 2, 2018 to recommend the Baldwin Street Conceptual Plan for consideration by council. I have emailed a copy to council and the consensus is that a review is in order before any action is taken. I will send an email requesting how Council wishes to proceed with this item.

GREEN LIGHT GO GRANT

An update has been sent to the state regarding the project. We had to make adjustments to the scope of work when the bids were received due to the cost involved. We will be installing adaptors on Station and Washington and Bower Hill and Washington. We will have to apply again to finish up with Prestley. Hopefully we can do a joint application with Collier including their lights to Kirwan Heights.

CHARTIERS PARK RESTROOM PROJECT

The contractor has been providing submittals to the engineers for approval. They have been given the notice to proceed from the COG. I have requested Engineer Sites contact the contractor to receive an updated schedule of the project.

CHARTIERS PARK COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

No Update: Work has stopped on this project due to budget constraints.

COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT YEAR 45 APPLICATION

We should receive notification in the next few months regarding this grant application. This application is for upgrades to the McLaughlin restrooms.

MCLAUGHLIN RUN PARK PROJECT

I am going to find out about this grant once and for all this month. This item has been hanging out with no confirmation for too long. I will provide information as soon as I find it. I do know the LWCF which provided the grant has folded. Someone at the DCNR should be able to tell me something. Engineer Sites has tried with no luck.

SUSTAINABILITY ASSESSMENT

No Update: I have been working on the Sustainable Pittsburgh Certification for some time now and am finding that a need for a Sustainability Assessment of the Boroughs' policies and practices may be in order. We provide programs such as the HHW program, leaf recycling, etc. to the public but do not have sustainability incorporated into our policies such as economics, social equity and the environment. Projects within the borough should be required to be environmentally responsible, profitable, and maintain a healthy place to live and work for the residents of the community. The DCED will be requiring communities be certified when considering grant applications. I have spoken with Carolyn from EPD regarding this subject and they do have certified planners that work with incorporating sustainable practices. I will report back after I have received more information regarding the process.
