REVIEW OF CONDITIONAL USE APPLICATION – 131 WASHINGTON AVENUE

A conditional use application submitted by the owner of the property, Thomas Bean, Jr. on behalf of the tenant Pittsburgh Pets at Home, LLC was submitted to the Planning Commission for the property located at 131 Washington Avenue. The applicant proposes to utilize the property for the establishment of a Pet Crematorium. The plan is subject to requirements in Section 903.29 of the Zoning Ordinance which also reference requirements in Section 1001 Performance Standards. The plan was reviewed for compliance to Borough standards and approved by the Planning Commission for the consideration of Council. The Planning Commissions' recommendation of approval of the plan by Council includes a contingency of landscaping upgrades and lighting upgrades to goose neck in order to create a cohesive façade with a current business in the area.
