ORDINANCE NO. 1022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CH. 15, MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, PART. 4, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, §15-402, PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, AND PART. 11, FIRE LANES, §15-1101, DESIGNATED FIRE LANES AND TOW AWAY ZONES, TO ESTABLISH A FIRE LANE AND PROHIBIT PARKING IN A DESIGNATED LOCATION ON McMILLEN STREET.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

I. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, General Parking Regulations, §15-402, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, is hereby amended to prohibit parking at all times along the following designated location on **McMillen Street**:

STREET: McMillen Street

SIDE: South

LOCATION: Starting from a point beginning 190 feet from the intersection of McMillen St. and Dewey Ave., and extending 50' West to a point along the frontage of 616 McMillen St.

II. That the Bridgeville Borough Code Of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part. 11, Fire Lanes, §15-1101, Designated Fire Lanes and Tow Away Zones, is hereby amended to designate and establish a Fire Lane and Tow Away Zone along the following designated location on **McMillen Street**:

STREET: McMillen Street

SIDE: South

LOCATION: Starting from a point beginning 190 feet from the intersection of McMillen St. and Dewey Ave., and extending 50' West to a point along the frontage of 616 McMillen St.

III. That, upon enactment, the Borough shall erect and maintain appropriate signage and pavement markings along the designated location to provide notice of said Fire Lane/Tow Away zone and No Parking zone.

IV. That all ordinances or portions of ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

V. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

VI. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under law.
