ORDINANCE NO. 1023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CH. 15, MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, PART. 4, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, §15-402, PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT ALL TIMES AND TO ESTABLISH A ‘LOADING ZONE’ IN A DESIGNATED LOCATION ON STATION STREET AT OR ABOUT THE STATION STREET-TAYLOR WAY INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, the Bridgeville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles & Traffic, Part 1, General Parking Regulations, §402, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, authorizes Borough Council to establish and designate by proper markings and signage, enforceable traffic and parking regulations, including ‘no-parking’ and ‘loading’ zones; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect and enhance public safety, and, more specifically, to improve the safe and unfettered vehicular access from Station Street to Taylor Way, while at the same time accommodating regular, but brief, deliveries and loading/unloading activities to adjacent and nearby merchants and businesses located on Station Street at or about the Station Street-Taylor Way intersection, the Borough Council’s Public Safety Committee, with the concurrence of the Borough Chief of Police, recommends that a No-Parking/Loading Zone be established on Station Street, beginning from the westerly side of Taylor Way-Station Street intersection and extending approximately twenty-six feet (26’) to the West along the frontage of 336 Station Street.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

I. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, General Parking Regulations, §15-402, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, is hereby amended to prohibit parking at all times along the following designated location on **Station Street**, and to establish a “15-Minute Loading Zone” at said location, as follows:

STREET: Station Street

SIDE: South

LOCATION: Beginning at the intersection of Taylor Way and Station Street, and extending 26' West to a point along the frontage of 336 Station Street.

II. That, upon enactment, the Borough shall erect and maintain appropriate signage and pavement markings along the designated location on Station Street to provide notice of said "No Parking/Loading (15-Minute Max.) Zone established by this Ordinance.

III. That all ordinances or portions of ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

IV. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

V. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under law.
