The Scope of Work will include 235 LF of soldier beam & concrete lagging retaining wall (varying heights), 600 SY of roadway milling and profiling; 220 SY of 8" depth 2A aggregate pavement subbase, 4" Superpave WMA binder course and 600 SY of 1½" Superpave WMA wearing course; 55 LF of keyway milling, 350 LF feet of bituminous wedge curb; 350 LF of 6" perforated underdrain, 230 LF of Type 31-S strong post guiderail; installation of three Type 'M' inlets and one 4' diameter storm manhole; with add alternate for Union Street, 80 LF of soldier beam & concrete lagging (variable height) retaining wall; 300 SY of Pavement Restoration; 85 LF of Type 31-S strong post guiderail;; plus all appurtenances, material, and labor necessary for installation and restoration.
