**ORDINANCE NO. 1025**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CH. 15, MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, PART. 4, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, §15-402, PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT ALL TIMES IN DESIGNATED LOCATIONS ON BOTH SIDES OF STATION STREET FROM WASHINGTON AVENUE TO DEWEY AVENUE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Bridgeville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles & Traffic, Part 1, General Parking Regulations, §402, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, authorizes Borough Council to establish and designate by proper markings and signage, enforceable traffic and parking regulations, including ‘no-parking’ and ‘loading’ zones; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect and enhance public safety, and, more specifically, to facilitate the safe and unfettered vehicular access along Station Street between the Station Street-Washington Avenue intersection and the Station Street-Dewey Avenue intersection, Borough Council, upon the Borough Council’s Public Safety Committee, recommends that a “No-Parking” zone be established on both sides of Station Street, beginning from the Station Street-Washington Avenue intersection and extending to Station Street-Dewey Avenue intersection.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

I. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, General Parking Regulations, §15-402, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, is hereby amended to prohibit parking at all times along the following designated locations on **Station Street as follows:**

**STREET: Station Street**

**SIDE: Both (South and North)**

**LOCATION: Beginning at the intersection of Washington Avenue and Station Street, and extending to the intersection of Station Street and Dewey Avenue.**

II. That, upon enactment, the Borough shall erect and maintain appropriate signage and pavement markings along the designated location on Station Street to provide notice of said “No Parking” Zone established by this Ordinance.

III. That all ordinances or portions of ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

IV. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

V. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under law.
