Cook School Park Basketball & Pickleball Court Improvements

The basketball court area at Cook School Park has been improved with funding assistance from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. The project included resurfacing the court area, replacing the fencing and basketball hoops, court striping and adding a new fenced-in pickleball court. Stop by the park and check out the improvements; there is something for everyone to enjoy!

Prestley Road at Charlet and Perrett St. Improvements

Late last year the Borough, working with PENNDOT's Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP), received advice from their traffic engineers on a low-cost way to improve the intersection of Prestley Road, Charlet Street, and Perret Street. The plan included a revised way this intersection should be marked. To improve visibility, the Public Works Department restriped where vehicles should stop at the end of Charlet Street, relocated the existing stop sign, and



painted a bump-out on Prestley Road with the goal of encouraging vehicles to slow down before turning onto Charlet Street and take the street with a slight turn versus cutting across closely to the vehicles exiting Perret Street.
