ORDINANCE NO. 1035

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, PART. 4, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, TO ADD NEW PROVISIONS RESTRICTING OR PROHIBITING THE PARKING OR STORAGE OF UNINSPECTED, UNREGISTERED OR DISMANTLED MOTOR VEHICLES, OR NONMOTORIZED TRAILERS, CAMPERS, RV's, MACHINERY, EQUIPMENT, GARBAGE/REFUSE CONTAINERS, MOVING OR STORAGE CONTAINERS, ON ANY BOROUGH STREETS AND ALLEYS.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

I. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, General Parking Regulations, is hereby amended to add new provisions restricting or prohibiting the Parking or Storage of Unlicensed, Uninspected, or Disabled Vehicles on any Borough Streets and Alleys, as follows:

§15-412. *Parking or Storage of Unlicensed, Uninspected, or Disabled Vehicles on Streets and Alleys Restricted or Prohibited.*

- A. Unlicensed or Uninspected Vehicles: It shall be unlawful for any person to park or store or allow to be parked or stored on any public street or public alley within the limits of the Borough any type of motor vehicle requiring a registration plate and a state inspection sticker under the applicable provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code if said motor vehicle does not have attached to it a current valid registration plate (i.e. license plate) and a current valid state inspection sticker as required under the applicable provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code.***
- B. Dismantled or Inoperable Vehicles: It shall be unlawful for any person to park or store or allow to be parked or stored on any public street or public alley within the limits of the Borough any type of motor vehicle requiring a registration plate and a state inspection sticker under the applicable provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code if such motor vehicle is to any extent partially dismantled and inoperable.***

II. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4, General Parking Regulations, is hereby amended to add new provisions restricting or prohibiting the Parking or Storage of trailers, boats, jet skis, motorcycles, ATV's, nonmotorized campers/RV's, Machinery/Equipment, Garbage/Refuse Containers, or Moving/Storage Containers on any Borough Streets and Alleys, as follows:

§15-413. Parking or Storage of Trailers, Campers/RV's, Boats, Jet Skis, Motorcycles, ATV's, Machinery, Equipment, Garbage/Refuse Containers, or Moving/Storage Containers on Streets and Alleys Restricted.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or store or allow to be parked or stored on any street or highway in the Borough for any period in excess of 48 hours any trailer (which shall mean a vehicle without motive power designed to be connected to a motor vehicle and used to carry property or living quarters, including but not limited to trailers used to support or transport nonmotorized campers/RV's, boats, jet skis, motorcycles, ATV's, machinery, equipment, etc.), any garbage/refuse containers or moving/storage boxes/containers, except when authorized by a temporary parking permit issued by the Borough Manager.

IV. That all ordinances or portions of ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

V. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

VI. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under law.
