ORDINANCE No. 1037

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CH. 15, MOTOR VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, PART 2, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, §15-211.1, STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED, SPECIFICALLY TO CREATE A 4-WAY STOP INTERSECTION FOR VEHICLES TRAVELING IN ALL DIRECTIONS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF BALDWIN STREET AND McLAUGHLIN RUN ROAD, AND AT MILL STREET AND McLAUGHLIN RUN ROAD.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeville, Allegheny County, as follows:

1. That the Bridgeville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, § 15-211.1, Stop Intersections Established, is hereby amended, specifically, to create to create a 4-way stop intersection for vehicles traveling in all directions at the intersections of Baldwin Street and McLaughlin Run Road, and at Mill Street and McLaughlin Run Road, as follows:

§ 211.1 Stop Intersections Established

<u>Stop Street</u>	<u>Intersection or Through Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
<i>Baldwin Street</i>	<i>McLaughlin Run Road</i>	<i>Easterly & Westerly</i>
<i>McLaughlin Run Road</i>	<i>Baldwin Street</i>	<i>Southerly & Northerly</i>
<i>Mill Street</i>	<i>McLaughlin Run Road</i>	<i>Easterly & Westerly</i>

2. That all ordinances or portions of ordinances which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

3. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

4. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment or as otherwise provided under the law.
